What are the rules for staying safe online?

- Don't give out personal information.
- Tell your parents if something makes you feel uncomfortable.
- Don't agree to meet with someone you meet online.
- Never send a picture of yourself to a stranger.
- Only share your passcode with your parents.
- Don't post anything hurtful or rude.
- Check with an adult before downloading and installing software.
